The center is strategically located along Springboro Pike at a signalized entrance to the Dayton Mall in a large and dominant retail trade area in the Greater Dayton region. The center also further benefits from strong demographics and daytime population in the immediate area and surrounding neighborhoods. The seller is in the process of replacing the roof which helps eliminate any significant building capital exposure in the near term. Dayton Mall Shoppes presents an exceptional value add opportunity for Fund II, through leasing and a moderate "facelift". We are acquiring the property significantly below replacement value in a top retail trade area in the Greater Dayton region.
